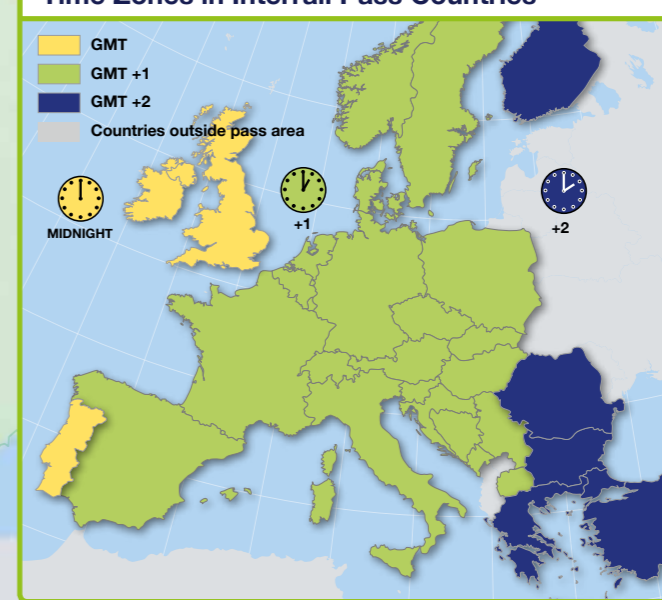

Currencies used in Interrail Pass Countries

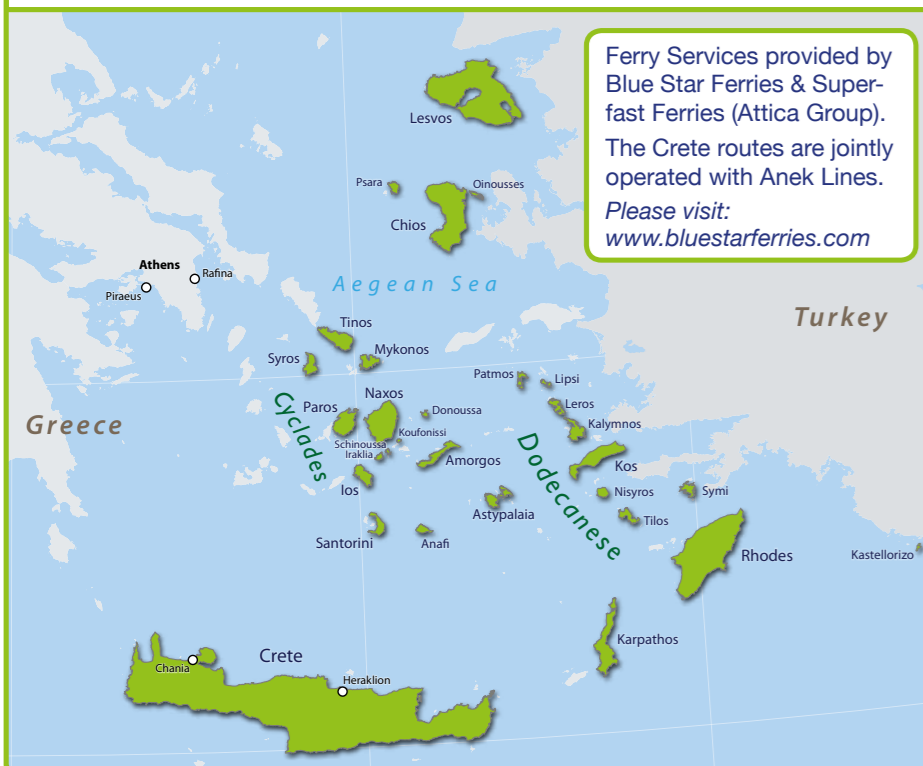
